

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Lesson: The Garden of Eden

Object Lesson

(15 minutes)

Hi children! Can you give a friend a hug? (Wait for children to hug). Would you like to sing a song? Well, my friend here (stuffed animal on lap) loves to sing to Jesus and I do too! Sing with me:

(sing "Jesus is our friend" two times)

Now we are going to read a story! (From the book Read Me a Bible Story, read The Garden of Eden (page 12)

- Encourage the children to look and touch the pictures on the • Story Board.
- Engage the children. "The child that pays the closes attention will get to hold my friend." (A special stuffed animal)
- As you are reading to the children be expressive. Encourage them to repeat key phrases after you, such as: God is our friend.
- After the story encourage the toddlers to complete a coloring page or do a craft.
- Ask guestions about the story.
- With the babies it helps to retell the story as you hold them and they look at the story board.

Teaching Tips

- Share the children's positive interactions with their parents.
- Be creative! Do not be embarrassed to make noises, use strange voices and funny facial expressions. This will help the infants and toddlers make a connection with you and the lesson.
- Lean on your Junior Helpers! They can be of great help by redirecting the older children and holding the babies while you teach.

Connect with the children by making motions as you tell the story.

Engage the children to do as you do.

Have the kids retell the story however they remember it!

The Garden of Eden (Genesis 2:8-20)
